DISINFECT SURFACES TO HELP PREVENT THE SPREAD OF COVID-19

HARD SURFACES:

① CLEAN

Remove organic material for effective disinfection so that sanitizers and disinfectants can reach the virus.



② RINSE

Rinse off detergents to avoid diluting or inactivating the disinfectant.

③ DISINFECT

Use a properly registered disinfectant and follow the directions on the product label. The disinfectant should claim to be effective against viruses similar to COVID-19.



FREQUENTLY TOUCHED OBJECTS:

CONSIDER PROVIDING DISPOSABLE WIPES for easy and frequent disinfection of high-touch surfaces, such as doorknobs, railings, elevator buttons, light switches, keyboards, phones and other devices.
